Choose from these and other topics:

(Programs are tailored to meet your needs – just ask!)

- **Native American Lore**

Experience Native American heritage through games, crafts, dress & food. Make a bead bracelet to take home!

- **Wacky Water Science**

Discover the amazing properties of water through wacky experiments. Can a penny hold 100 drops of water?

- **Kitchen Sink Science**

Polymers have amazing properties. We'll make goopy, stretchy substances and have a great time!

- **Mystery Minerals**

Can you uncover the identity of our 5 unknown rocks & minerals? We'll use simple scientific tests to find out.

- **Amazing Mammals**

Feel the fur of a deer and learn how to track a raccoon as we explore the amazing world of mammals.

- **Aquatic Animals**

Peek into the mysteries of the deep, as you meet some of the Coastal Center's resident sea creatures.

- **Scales and Tails**

A turtle walks, a frog hops, and a snake slithers. Meet reptiles and amphibians and discover why they're unique.

- **Spineless Wonders**

Meet creatures with their skeleton on the outside. Maybe a tarantula, hissing roach, or butterfly will appear!

- **Birds of a Feather (Includes Owls)**

We'll flock together to meet our neighborhood birds, learn to use binoculars, and how to attract birds to our yard.

Program Details

- Each session contains age-appropriate, hands-on activities, props, and live animals. All programs are taught by professional educators.
- For a 5-week series (one program per week), total program cost is \$450 (includes travel). Longer series are available upon request.
- Class size: 14 students maximum.
- Age Range: Programs are appropriate for K-5th grade. Please try to limit age range of groups. A mixed group of K-3rd grade works well, or 3rd-5th grade.
- Program Length: Approximately one hour per class.
