Schoolyard Nature Hike

Using your school's playground or nature trail, an experienced Audubon naturalist will guide students through a walk of discovery. Students will use their 5 senses to discover the natural surprises all around them.



Let's Go Buggy!

See the world through a bug's eye view! Discover the difference between an insect and an arachnid through fun games and songs. Students will also meet some of the Coastal Center's favorite insects.

Native Americans

Step into the past! Experience the history of local Native Americans through story telling, playing Native American games, learning about their food and clothing, and more. Students will make their own "wampum" bracelets to take home.

Nails, Tails and Scales

Meet some of the Coastal Center's live lizards, turtles and snakes, and discover what makes reptiles unique. Includes props and hands-on activities.



Animals Getting Ready for Winter

Not all animals hibernate during the winter. Discover the many other strategies animals have for surviving the winter. Plus, meet an animal that goes to the extremes to survive the cold!

Aquatic Animals

Students meet the Coastal Center's live aquatic animals, handle real props, and discover the amazing adaptations these creatures have to their environment.

Feathered Friends

Get your feathers ruffled as we learn what makes birds special. Program uses bird mounts, nests, feathers and other props. Programs at the Coastal Center may include observing birds in the Sanctuary (weather permitting).

Migrating Monarchs

Butterflies are amazing creatures! Discover the life cycle of the Monarch Butterfly in this interactive program. Students learn how Monarchs are caught, tagged and released to help scientists learn more about these amazing creatures. This program includes the option of an outdoor insect
