### HITTING THE TRAIL – June 22 - 26

Summer is the time to get on your bike! After reviewing bike safety and learning basic bike maintenance, we'll head out on the Airline Trail and other off-road locations.

### BIRDING ON BIKES – July 13 - 17

We share area trails with a wide variety of birds and other wildlife. We'll pedal through different habitats, in search of our feathered friends. Binoculars and field guides are provided. Routes will be primarily on dirt roads and trails.

### HISTORY ON WHEELS – August 17 - 21

For more experienced cyclists, we'll enjoy longer rides while learning about local history along the way. Routes will be primarily on dirt roads and trails.

Drop off and pick up locations will vary throughout the week, depending on weather and group dynamics. Properly fitted bicycle and helmet, spare tube, backpack, and water bottles are a must.
